## How to Separate and Dispose of Garbage and Recyclables

## Basic rules for garbage disposal

- Please check the following rules and dispose of garbage to the collection point by 8:00 a.m. on the collection day.
- To use recyclable garbage effectively, they are collected by categories. Before disposal, please separate garbage by categories.
- Recyclables, Non-burnable and Oversized garbage are collected by categories (materials) per collection cars respectively.
- It is a crime to take out recyclables from the collection point. Do not carry away recyclable goods put at the collection point by others.
- When having a large amount of trash due to moving-out or in, you cannot put them out at the collection point. Please contact Environmental Section (049-262-9022) or bring them to the Environmental Center directly by yourself.
- Collection days vary depending on the area. Make sure to check attached "Garbage Collection Calendar" and confirm the schedule and items of your area.
- You cannot dispose of garbage for business purpose. Please contact Environmental Section (049-262-9022) for more detailed information on the disposal.
   \*You may have troubles with the neighbors when ignoring the rule of garbage disposal.

	<b>Beverage</b> Cans	Cans of beverages such as juice or beer (You can't dispose of cans other than those of beverages such as cans of canned food, cookie cans, spray cans and paint cans. These items should be put out as non-burnable garbage.)	Remove caps, rinse the inside with water and put them in the designated dark green mesh bag for beverage cans at collection place.(Flatten aluminum cans. Do not flatten steel cans. Do not put them in the plastic bags.)	
	PET Bottles	PET bottles with this PET bottle logo. PET bottles for / of beverage, etc.	Remove caps·labels, rinse the inside with water, flatten PET bottles and put them in the designated yellow-green mesh bag for PET bottles at collection place.(Do not put them in the plastic bags.)	
	Magazines Other paper items	All items with this logo Magazines, Catalogs, Envelopes, Paper bags, Paper boxes, Wrapping papers, Small papers, Shredded pa- per, etc.	Put them in a paper bag, etc. and bundle them. Magazines · Catalogs: Fold and bundle them with a string. When disposing of shredded papers, please put them in another bag.	
	Plastic Containers/ Packaging	All items with this logo. Expanded polystyrene, Containers made of styrofoam, Caps / Labels of PET bottles, Plastic bags of confectioneries, Containers of noodles, Tubes of mayonnaises, Packs of eggs, Plastic shopping bags, etc.	Put them in transparent or semi-transparent bags. Empty containers such as food, beverages, seasonings, detergents. remove waste. If the dirt still remains, dispose of them as burnable garbage.	All zone/ Wednesday
Plastics other than Packaging Containers		Polyethylene plastic buckets, Polyethylene tanks, Rulers, Toys, Toothbrushes, Floats, Ballpoint pens, Clothing cases, Plastic hangers, Video cassettes, CD, etc.	Put them in transparent or semi-transparent bags. Video cassettes, Cassette tapes: Separate them from other items and put them in the bags.	- Zone A/ Monday Zone B/ Tuesday Zone C/ Thursday
Non-burnable Garbage		Pans, Vases, Wire frames of umbrellas, Cans other than beverages · Paint cans · Oil cans (Empty the can before disposal), Home electric appliances that are less than 50cm (remove batteries), Glasses · Potteries · Blades (Wrap sharp objects in a paper), etc.   *Items that are 50cm or longer are oversized garbage.	Separate the garbage into items and put them in transparent or semi-transparent bags.	
	Harmful Garbage	Dry-Cell Batteries(put them in the special bag for batteries), Fluorescent lights, Mercury thermometers, Mirrors·Lighters, Spray cans, Cooking gas canister(Empty them before disposal, and remove caps), etc.	Separate the garbage into items and put them in transparent or semi-transparent bags. Fluorescent lights and Mercury thermometers: Put them in the attached case.	Zone D/ Friday *every other week
	Oversized Garbage	Material combustible, with longest side of 30cm or more, material incombustible, with a length of 50cm or more, home appliances, large furniture, futon, etc.  **Part of Oversized Garbage will be charged from April, 2020. For details see the attached paper.	If many of large articles are disposed at once, collecting will be impossible. Please dispose it separately. (Up to 2 articles per one household). Please disassemble it in small pieces as far as possible.	
	Burnable Garbage	Kitchen garbage, Paper scraps, Used cooking oil (Either solidify the oil or absorb the oil in paper), Stuffed Toys, Cushions, Dispos- able diapers (remove waste), Shoes, Rubber products, Small branches, Splinter of wood, etc.	Put them in transparent or semi-transparent bags. Kitchen garbage: Drain liquid completely before disposal.	Zone A·Zone C/ Tuesday and Friday Zone B·Zone D/ Monday and Thursday
